

Texas Deregulation Map: Overview

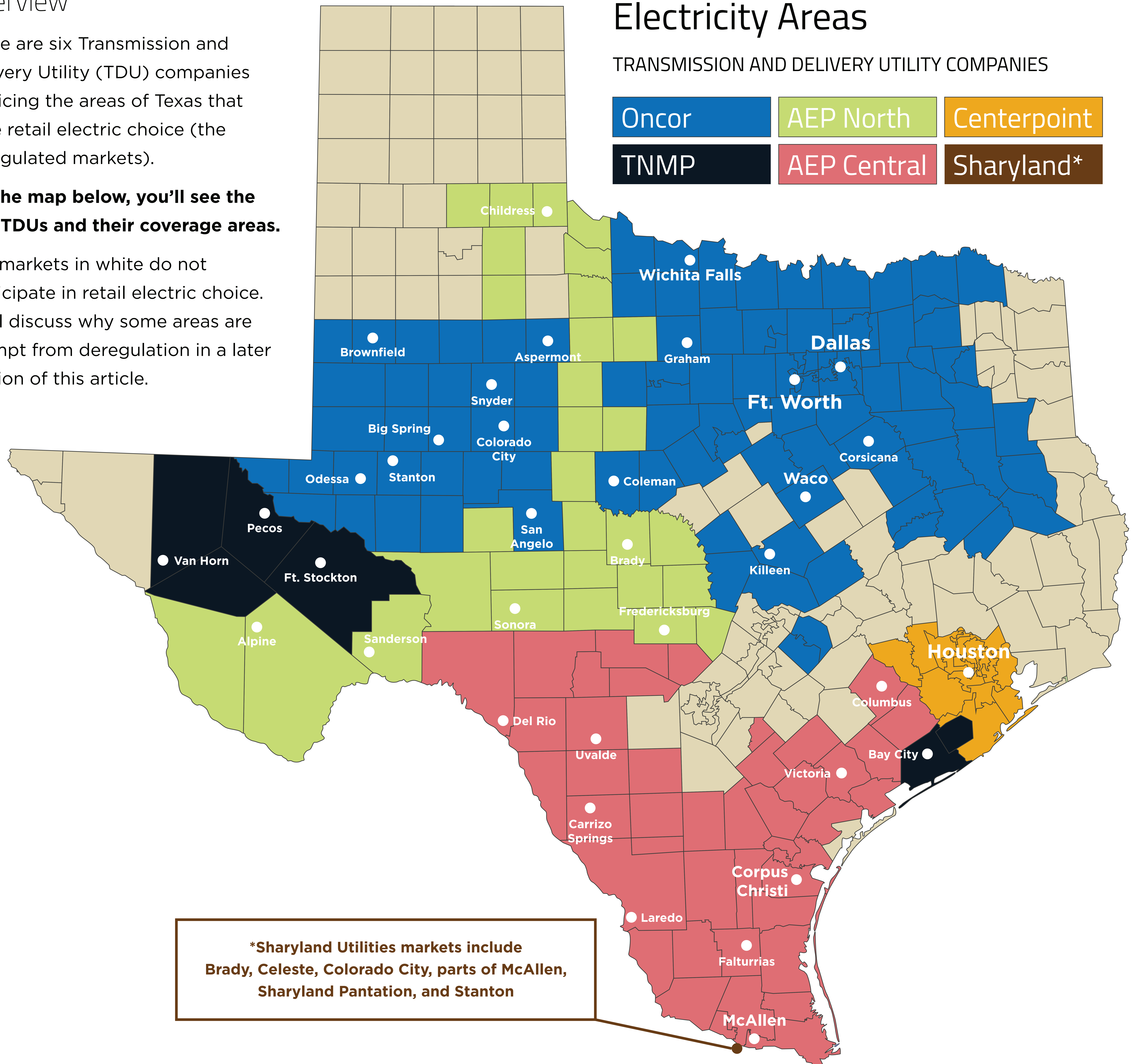
There are six Transmission and Delivery Utility (TDU) companies servicing the areas of Texas that have retail electric choice (the deregulated markets).

In the map below, you'll see the six TDUs and their coverage areas.

The markets in white do not participate in retail electric choice. We'll discuss why some areas are exempt from deregulation in a later section of this article.

Texas Regulated Map: Overview

As you can see, the regulated areas of Texas account for only about 25% of the land area of Texas. The remaining 75% of the state is deregulated.
